





RECIPES FOR THE HOLIDAY SEASON





This drink give off sangria vibes, but the white wine makes it both refreshing and belly warming at the same time.

Instructions


Combine 2 bottles dry white wine, 1/2 cup honey and 1/4 cup calvados or brandy in a medium pot over medium heat Add 6 each allspice berries, black peppercorns and star anise pods, 4 slices fresh ginger, 2 cinnamon sticks and 2 wide strips each lemon and orange zest. Bring to a low simmer and cook 10 to 15 minutes (do not boil). Add a few lemon and orange slices to the pot before serving.

Ingredients

- 1 cup of peanut butter
- 60 butter crackers, such as Ritz (2 sleeves)
- 2 1/2 cups milk chocolate chips
- · Sprinkles for decorating

Instructions

- Line a baking sheet with parchment. Spread a generous 1 teaspoon peanut butter onto half of the crackers and then top with the remaining crackers. Place on the prepared baking sheet and refrigerate until the peanut butter is firm, 20 to 30 minutes.
- Put the chocolate chips in a microwave-safe bowl and microwave on medium power in 15-second intervals, stirring after each interval, until melted, 1 minute 15 seconds to 1 minute 30 seconds. (You can also melt the chocolate in a double boiler.) Use 2 forks to dip each sandwich cookie into the melted chocolate until completely coated. If the chocolate starts to stiffen, return it to the microwave and reheat slightly.
- Put the cookies back on the baking sheet and decorate with the sprinkles. Refrigerate until firm, about 30 minutes. Store in an airtight container at room temperature for up to 1 week.
